Best Time to Visit Africa

Africa is a year-round destination, but the best season depends on what you want to see.

Dry Season (May-October)

- Best wildlife viewing
- Animals gather at waterholes
- Cooler, less humid
- Peak safari season

Green/Rainy Season (November-April)

- Lush landscapes + dramatic skies
- Baby animals + great birdwatching
- Fewer crowds + lower prices
- Some areas have short rains only

Tip box:

For Victoria Falls, the biggest flow is Feb-May, while best visibility is Jun-Oct.



Southern Africa (South Africa, Botswana, Zimbabwe, Namibia, Madagascar)

- Great for first-timers
- Kruger National Park safari is easy to access
- Botswana offers high-end wilderness (Chobe + Okavango)
- Victoria Falls is a must-see
- Namibia for deserts + scenic drives

East Africa (Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Rwanda)

- Best for migration safaris
- Serengeti + Masai Mara for Big Cats
- Gorilla trekking in Uganda/Rwanda
- Cultural villages + Rift Valley lakes

Island Add-Ons

- Zanzibar, Seychelles, Mauritius, Mozambique
- Perfect after safari for beaches + relaxation

- Kruger National Park (South Africa) Big Five, great value, safari for all budgets.
- Chobe National Park (Botswana) best elephants in Africa, river safaris.
- Okavango Delta (Botswana) luxury wilderness, mokoro canoe safaris.

- Masai Mara (Kenya) iconic lions + wildebeest crossing.
- Etosha National Park (Namibia) salt pans, selfdrive friendly.

- Victoria Falls + Zambezi (Zimbabwe/Zambia) safari

SAMPLE ITINERARIES (SOUTHERN AFRICA)


Itinerary 1: 7 Days South Africa Safari + Panorama Route

- Day 1: Arrival Johannesburg → transfer to Hazyview
- Day 2-3: Full-day Kruger safaris
- Day 4: Panorama Route (Blyde Canyon, God's Window)
- Day 5-6: Kruger safaris + cultural stop
- Day 7: Return to Johannesburg / flight onward

Itinerary 2: 5 Days Victoria Falls + Chobe Safari

- Day 1: Victoria Falls sightseeing
- Day 2: Zambezi sunset cruise
- Day 3-4: Chobe game drives + river safari
- Day 5: Departure







Itinerary 3: 10 Days Kenya + Tanzania Migration Safari

- Serengeti (3 nights)

SAFARI PACKING LIST

What to Pack for an African Safari

Essentials

- Neutral clothing (khaki/olive/earth tones)
- Light jacket for mornings & evenings
- Comfortable closed shoes
- Hat + sunglasses
- Sunscreen + insect repellent
- Refillable water bottle
- Binoculars + camera
- Power bank + universal adapter

Health & Documents

- Passport + visas (if needed)
- Travel insurance
- Malaria tablets (for risk areas)
- Basic meds (painkillers, antihistamines, stomach meds)

Pro tip:

Many fly-in safaris allow 15-20kg soft luggage only.

Is Africa Safe to Travel?

Short answer: Yes — when you plan smartly. Safety tips

- Travel with a reputable local operator
- Don't walk alone at night in big cities
- Keep valuables discreet
- Follow guide instructions in wildlife areas
- Use registered transport

Health tips

- Check recommended vaccines
- Malaria prevention for certain parks
- Drink bottled or filtered water in remote areas
- Bring sunscreen + hydrate often






Africa Trip Planning Checklist
